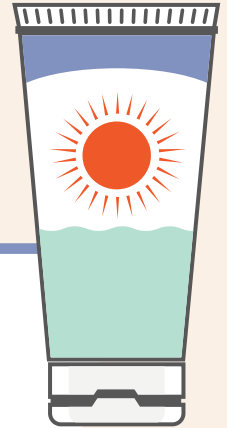


## CLEANING STAINS:

Sunscreens are mostly oil-based products. Oil from sunscreen can, over time leave stains on the chairs. One thing you can do to avoid sunscreen stains is to wait until the sunscreen fully dries down before laying on the chairs.



As sunscreen is an oil-based product, the first step is to remove the oil. We suggest using a degreaser such as Dawn Dish soap or Oxyclean.



1. Pour the grease-cutting dish detergent directly on the stained area. Utilize a damp sponge to trickle water onto the stained area.

2. Allow the dish detergent to soak on the plastic for **5-10 minutes**. Then scrub using the moist sponge. Pour more warm water and detergent if the stain is hard to eliminate.

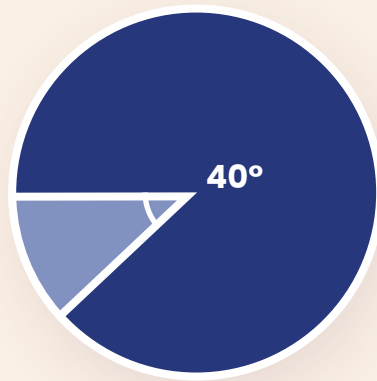


3. Rinse carefully with warm water and dry the chair using a towel. Check the surface of the chair by touching it. If it still feels slightly greasy, repeat the steps above and re-wash using the dish detergent until it feels and looks clean.

## CLEANING STAINS – ADVANCED:

### PRESSURE WASHING:

Pressure Washing is also a very effective method in removing stains, dirt and debris. When pressure washing, use low to medium pressure (high pressure can damage the surface).



**NOTE:** We suggest using a wider fan shaped nozzle, approximately 40 degrees.
